



## **TRANSPORTATION POLICY OF AL-MUSTAQBAL UNIVERSITY COLLEGE**

The following transportation policies are developed to provide the optimum convenience for both students and staff in the university. Furthermore, these policies are considering the health and safety for all people who would like to travel to and from the university campus. This policy covers various types of trips for employees, students, and guests. The policy has given great consideration for the climate change mitigation to achieve the net zero carbon emissions by 2030.

### **FUNDEMENTAL ONE: TRANSPORTATION POLICY FOR UNIVERSITY VEHICLES**

All university vehicles should be used only for university official business and events. The university assures that every driver must be over 21 years old and have a driving experience of five years for the university vans or shuttles and three years for personal vehicles. It is not allowed to keep these vehicles outside the university overnight or longer times unless there was arranged reservations. It is not allowed to use alcoholic beverages and other illegal materials inside these vehicles anywhere and anytime.

### **FUNDEMENTAL TWO: LOW CARBON TRANSPORTATION STRATEGY**

Al-Mustaqbal University College has committed to its strategy which concentrates on the challenges caused by the climate change. The contribution to reduce carbon footprint is a vital task which is extremely valorised by the university vision. The university strategy is to encourage the use of public transport such as, buses, shuttles, etc., instead of the personal private cars to reduce carbon emissions. All university staff and students are prohibited to use their own vehicles to transport students for an official university-sponsored off-campus events such as field trips and scientific trips. The university provides buses to operate such these activities. The university is encouraging the staff and students to use hybrid and electric cars by providing free parking systems for electric vehicles.

### **FUNDEMENTAL THREE: PARKING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM**

The university has developed an integrated parking system to provide a convenience transportation for employees and students. The current university campus has two separated large vehicle's parking. The first one is for staff only and the second one for the students and visitors. These parks are designed according to the ideal health and safety considerations and contains all the required safety tools and equipment. The university ensures that all staff have permits to allow them to use the parking service. These permits are allocated based on a managed application system which all the staff require a parking space are advised to apply through this system to get a permission. The university is ensuring that disabled parking spaces are in proper location which is nearby accessible routes to the university's buildings.
