
What is the Past Continuous Tense?



Introduction

past continuous tense: \checkmark (also known as past progressive tense) is used to describe an action or event that was ongoing at a specific time in the past, can also be used to describe two or more actions that were happening at the same time in the past.

Introduction



Last week , last night , yesterday , last month ...

Form affirmative sentence

Subject + was/were + (verb) ing + complement.



EX:

- 1- I was eating breakfast yesterday.
- 2- He was sleeping Last week .
- 3- They were watching TV yesterday.

Form Interrogative sentence

 The question in the past continuous tense is used to ask about an action that was in progress at a specific time in the past. It is formed using The following structure:

Form Interrogative sentence

Wh (Q) + Was/were + subject + verb + -ing + complement ?

Ex:

- 1. What were you doing at 10 pm last night?
- 2. Where were they going when you saw them?
- 3. Why was she sleeping so soundly when you arrived?

Form Interrogative sentence

Was/were + subject + verb + -ing +complement ?

Ex:

1-were you studying for your exam when I called ?

2- Was she cooking dinner when the power went out ?

Form negative sentence

Subject + was/were not + verb-ing + complement .

- 2. The children were not playing in the park.
- 3. She was not working on the project yesterday.
