Project Management

According to ISO 9000/2000

A **project** is a unique **process**, consisting of a set of coordinated and controlled activities with start and finish dates, undertaken to achieve an objective conforming to specific requirements, including the constraints of time, cost and resources.

The outcome of a project may be one or several units of **product**.

A product is the result of a process.

A **process** is a set of interrelated or interacting activities which transforms inputs to outputs.

Characteristic of a project

A unique, one-time operational activity or effort Requires the completion of a large number of interrelated activities

Established to achieve specific objective Resources, such as time and/or money, are limited

Typically has its own management structure Need leadership

Project management



It is the Coordinated activities to direct and control a project organization to realize a set of defined deliverables up to quality standards and requirements.

<u>project manager</u>

He is the professional specialist who plans and controls a project. He is the person who acts in a transparent manner for the sake of the whole project to satisfy the expectations of the customers, the partners delivering goods and services for the project and the other interested parties
