


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



I am "I am from Spain."

You are "You are a student."

He/She/It is "She is a teacher."

We/You/They are "They are from Brazil."

Negative Form:

Subject Verb (to be) Negative Example "I am not from Italy." Ι am not "You aren't a teacher." You are not / aren't is not / isn't "She isn't a doctor." He/She/It "We aren't from Japan." We/You/They are not / aren't
