Country	Nationality	Example Sentence
England	English	"I am from England. I am English."
Spain	Spanish	"He is from Spain. He is Spanish."
Japan	Japanese	"She is from Japan. She is Japanese."
Brazil	Brazilian	"We are from Brazil. We are Brazilian."
Egypt	Egyptian	"They are from Egypt. They are Egyptian."
Example: "Cristiano Ronaldo is from Portugal. He is Portuguese. He is a football player. He lives in Saudi Arabia."

Positive Form:

Subject	Verb (to be)	Example
I	am	"I am from Spain."
You	are	"You are a student."
He/She/It	is	"She is a teacher."
We/You/They	are	"They are from Brazil."

Negative Form:

Subject	Verb (to be)	Negative	Example
I	am not		"I am not from Italy."
You	are not / aren't		"You aren't a teacher."
He/She/It	is not / isn't		"She isn't a doctor."
We/You/They	are not / aren't		"We aren't from Japan."

Question Form:

Question Word		Verb (to be)	Subject Example
Where am	I	am	"Where am I from?"
Where is	he/she/it	is	"Where is she from?"
Where are	you/we/they	are	"Where are they from?"
