Indirect Questions

Indirect questions are a little more formal and polite. We use them when talking to a person we don't know very well, or in professional situations, and their form is a little different.

Phrases for Indirect Questions

Could you tell me...

Do you know...
I was wondering...
Do you have any idea...
I'd like to know...
Would it be possible...
Is there any chance...

Direct: Where is the college?

Indirect: Could you tell me where the college is?

Direct: When does the lecture begin?

Indirect: **Do you know** when the lecture begin ?

Direct: Why did we stay at home?

Indirect: I was wondering why we stayed at home.

Direct: Has the game started?

Indirect: **Do you have any idea** whether / if the game has started?

Direct: Are they coming with her?

Indirect: I'd like to know whether / if they are coming with her.

Direct: Can you finish the project by tomorrow?

Indirect: Would it be possible (for you) to finish the project by

tomorrow?

Indirect: Can you share this post?

Indirect: Would it be possible to share this post?

Direct Question: Can we change the meeting?

Indirect Question: Is there a chance we can change the meeting?
