Loss of vision over few minutes to days

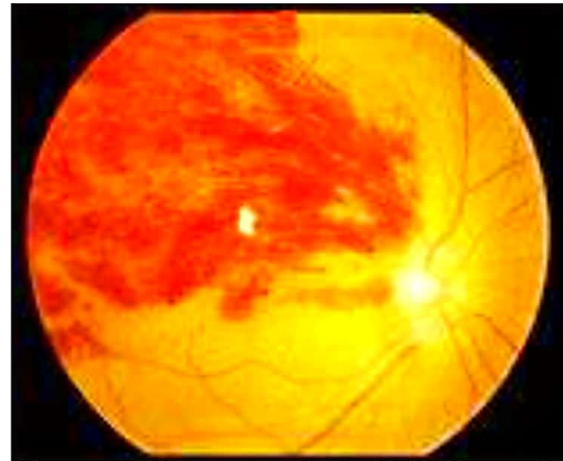
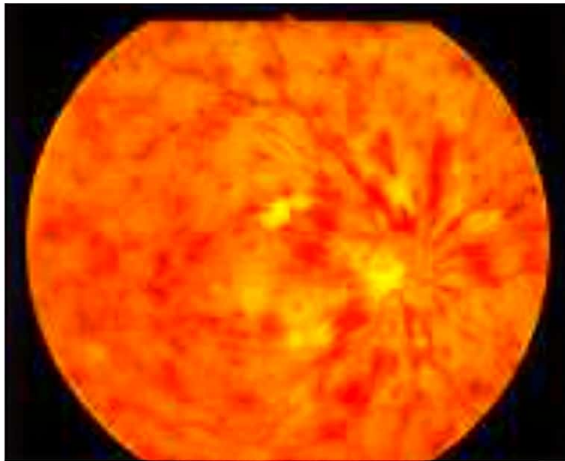
Unilateral or Bilateral

Part or full visual field

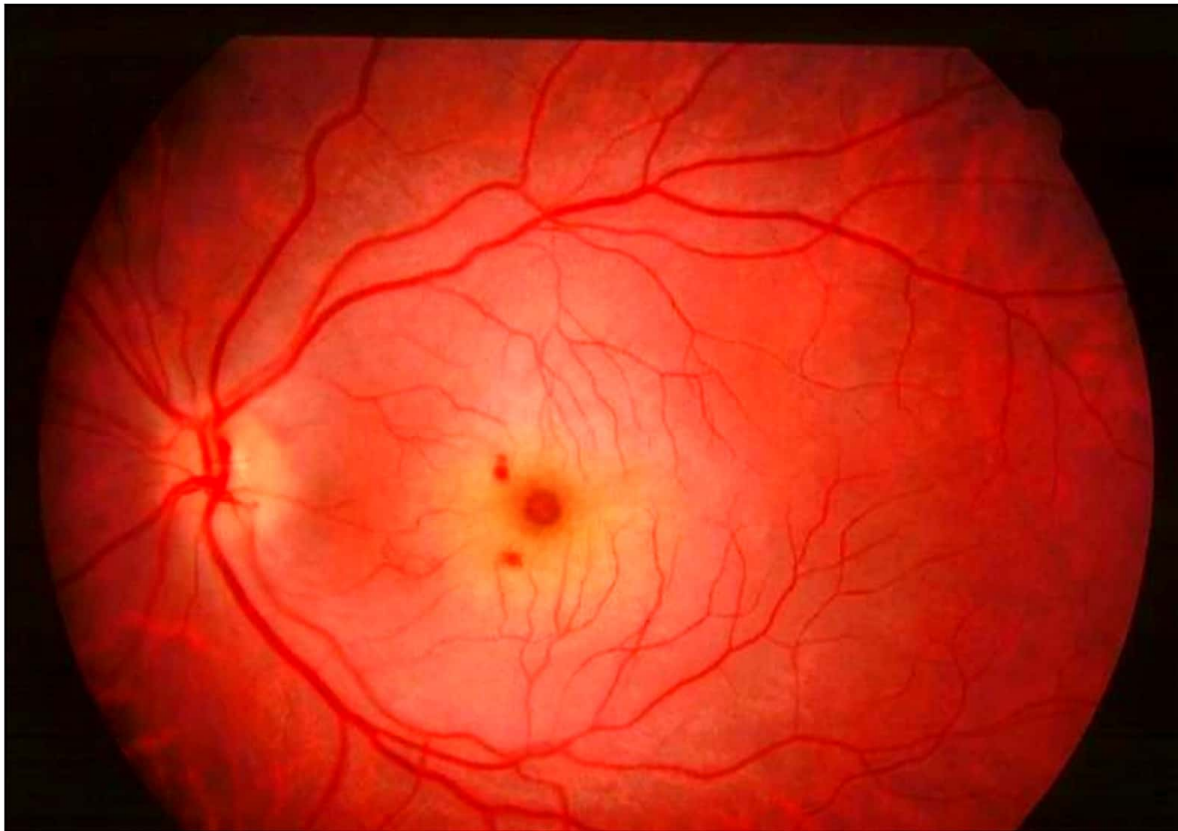

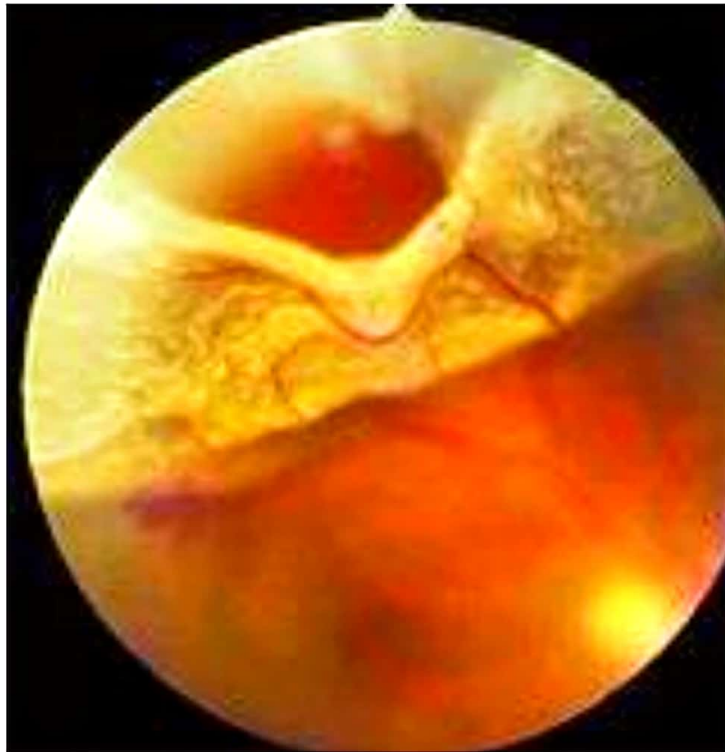
1. Retinal vein occlusion



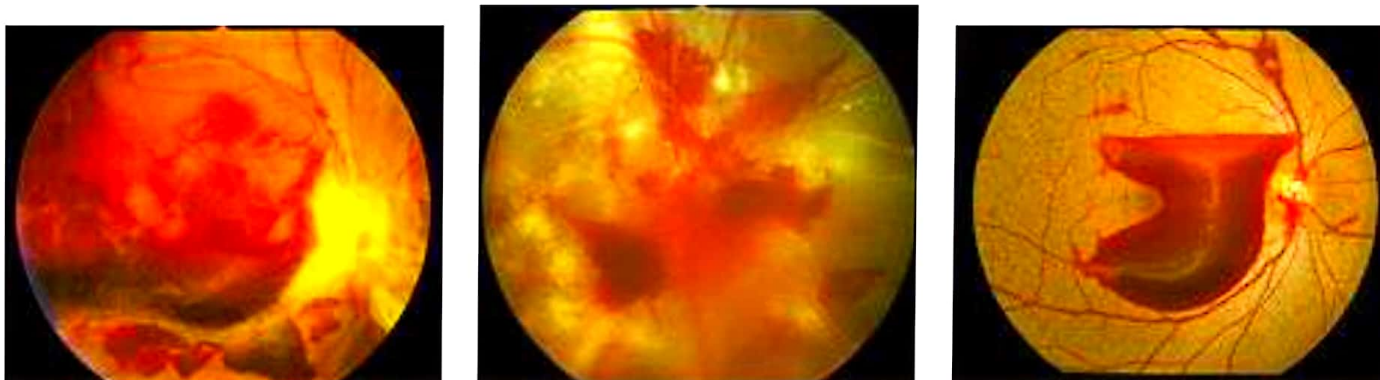
2. Central retinal artery occlusion



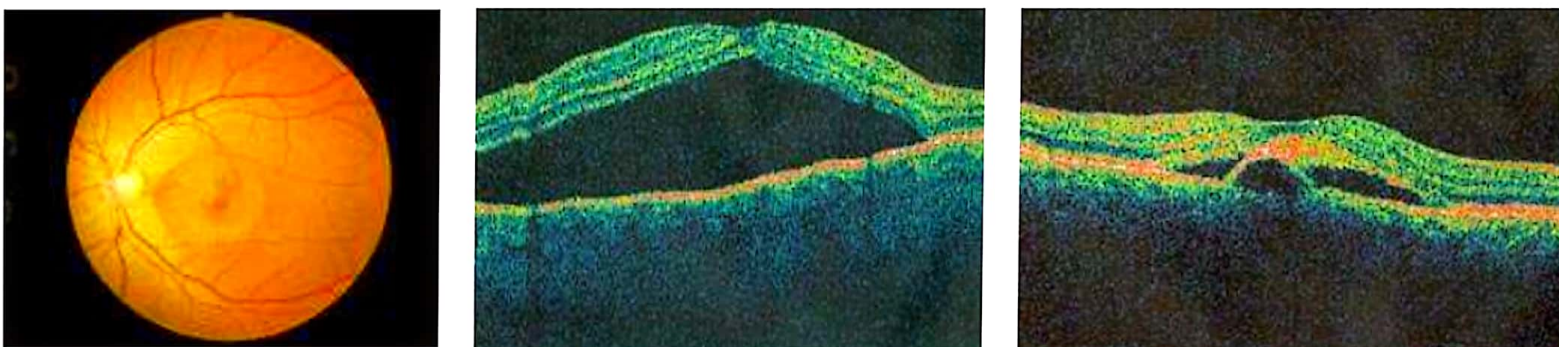
