The Administrative Discipline

الانضباط الإداري

Steps

Discipline is the group of procedures that the state performs in order to establish order in the society. The state issues the legal rules which draw the borders between order and the personal freedom. Discipline is legislative if the legislator puts the laws that organize the general freedom. It can be judicial if the judge punishes those who commit crimes.

الانضباط هو مجموعة الإجراءات التي تقوم بها الدولة من أجل إقامة النظام في المجتمع. تصدر الدولة القواعد القانونية التي ترسمها الحدود بين النظام والحرية الشخصية الانضباط هو التشريعية إذا وضع المشرع القوانين التي تنظم العامة حرية. ويمكن أن يكون قضائيًا إذا عاقب القاضي مرتكبيه الجرائم.

Discipline can also be administrative when the administration limits the personal freedom in order to impose security in the society. It punishes those who commit any immoral behavior in the street, in a magazine or in the cinema. A person may be punished if he publishes or sells pictures or books that do not respect the morals of our society. This is the business of the general administrative discipline. As for the special administrative
