

Question Words


What is Wh_question?

- Meaning of Wh_question in English is a request for information.
- Wh- questions usually start with a word beginning with wh-, but "how" is also included.
- Wh-questions ask for information and we do not expect a yes-no answer. For example:-
- A: Where's the coffee machine? (We expect an answer about the location of the coffee machine.)
- **B**: It's in the room next to the reception.

Wh_ question word	Usage	Examples
What	Use to ask about a thing	What's your name? My name is Mary.
Who	Use to ask about a person	Who's at the room? He's Ali.
Where	Use to ask about a place	Where do you work? I work at university.
When	Use to ask about a time	When do you take lunch? At 9:10.

Wh_question words

Which	Use to ask about a choice	Which one do you prefer? The pink one.
Whose	Use to ask about ownership	Whose pen is this? It's mine.
Whom	Use to ask about an object of a verb	Whom did you meet? I met my teacher.
Why	Use to ask about a reason	Why do you study English? Because I like English.
How	Use to ask about method\way	How do you go to work? I go by bus.
