1- See , Look at , Watch

See : means noticing something using our eyes.

For example : I see my friend in the market today.

Look at : when we look at something , we direct our eyes in its direction and pay attention to it.

For example : Look at the rain . It's so heavy.

Watch : is similar to look at , but it usually means that we look at something for a period of time.

For example : we watch TV. every evening.
