THE RULE OF PAST SIMPLE

• The past simple refers to an action that happened at a definite time in the past and the action is finished.

• Sub + verb (regular or irregular) + Complement.

PAST SIMPLE

- We can use the adverbs (yesterday, ago, and last) with past simple.
- She went to the university yesterday.
 - Sub irregular verb C Adv.
- We arrived yesterday.
- Sub regular verb Adv

PAST SIMPLE

Present Past

- Go = went
- Come = came
- have = had
- Make = made
- See = saw
- Say = said
- Do = did

THE RULE OF QUESTION

- We use did to make question:
- Did + Sub + V . (infinitive) + C + ?
- Ex// I- Did she go to the university?
 - 2- Did she go out at the weekend?
 - 3- Did she like the food in the restaurant?

THE RULE OF NEGATIVE

- We use didn't in negative sentences:
- The rule. Sub + didn't + V. (infinitive) + C.
- Ex// I- She didn't go to the university.
 - 2- She didn't go the cinema yesterday.
 - 3- She didn't go out at the weekend.
 - 4- She didn't like the food in the restaurant.

DO AS REQUIRED

- I- He (not/ arrive) yesterday. (Past simple)
- 2- I (do) it two months ago. (Past simple)
- 3- I (call) you last week. (Correct)
- 4- She (message) me yesterday. (Correct)
- 5- We (walk) to the house two hours ago. (Correct)
- 6- You (talk) to Sami last year. (Correct)
