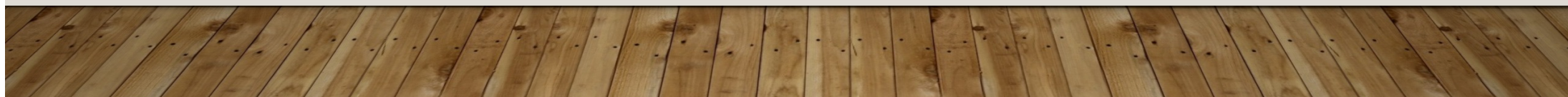

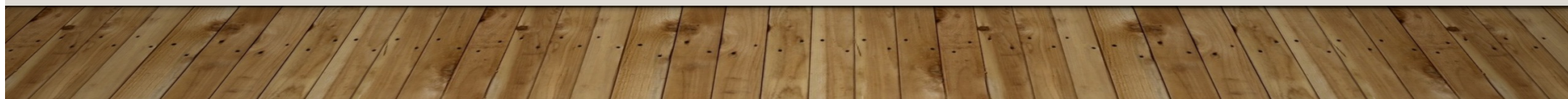

# YES/NO QUESTIONS

---

- **Are they** working hard? Yes, **They are** working hard.
- **Will they** be working hard? Yes, **They will** be working hard.
- **Had they** worked hard? Yes, **They had** worked hard.
- **Have they** been working hard? Yes, **They have** been working hard.
- **Might they** have been working hard? Yes, **They might** have been working hard.



# NEGATIVES

---

- They **are** **not/aren't** working hard.
- They **will** **not** be working hard.
- They **had** **not** worked hard.
- They **have** **not** been working hard.
- They **might** **not** have been working hard.

# PRESENT SIMPLE AND PAST SIMPLE QUESTIONS AND NEGATIVES

---

- **Do** they work hard?
  - They work hard.
  - They **do not** (**don't**) work hard.
- **Does** he work hard?
  - He works hard.
  - He **does not** (**doesn't**) work hard.
- **Did** they work hard?
  - They worked hard.
  - They **did not** (**didn't**) work hard.

Positives	Questions	Negatives
<i>I am (I'm)</i>	<i>Am I?</i>	<i>I am not (I'm not)</i>
<i>He is (he's)</i>	<i>Is he?</i>	<i>He is not (He's not/He isn't)</i>
<i>She is (she's)</i>	<i>Is she?</i>	<i>She is not (She's not/She isn't)</i>
<i>It is (it's)</i>	<i>Is it?</i>	<i>It is not (It's not/It isn't)</i>
<i>You are (you're)</i>	<i>Are you?</i>	<i>You are not (You're not/You aren't)</i>
<i>They are (they're)</i>	<i>Are they?</i>	<i>They are not (They're not/They aren't)</i>



Positives	Questions	Negatives
<i>I was</i>	<i>Was I?</i>	<i>I was not (I wasn't)</i>
<i>He was</i>	<i>Was he?</i>	<i>He was not (He wasn't)</i>
<i>She was</i>	<i>Was she?</i>	<i>She was not (She wasn't)</i>
<i>It was</i>	<i>Was it?</i>	<i>It was not (It wasn't)</i>
<i>You were</i>	<i>Were you?</i>	<i>You were not (You weren't)</i>
<i>They were</i>	<i>Were they?</i>	<i>They were not (They weren't)</i>

# QUESTIONS WITH *WHEN, WHERE, WHY*

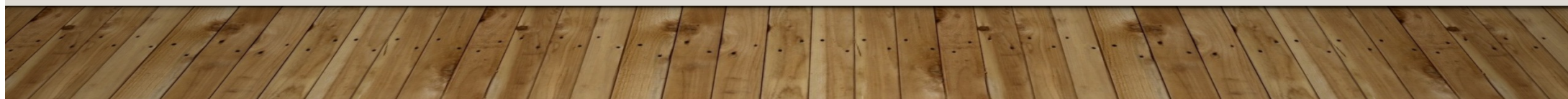
---

  - He is seeing **Ahmed** tomorrow.
- **What** do you want for your birthday?
  - I want **a computer** for my birthday.
- **Which** would you prefer, tea or coffee?
  - I'd prefer **some tea**.

- Who **did you give** the money **to**?
  - I **gave** the money **to** my brother.
- Where **does she come from**?
  - She **comes from** Madrid.
- How long **were they waiting for**?
  - They **were waiting for** an hour.
