DESCRIPTION Berkhamsted is a historic market town 20 miles north of London. It has a population of 19,000, and is in the middle of beautiful English countryside.

PLACES OF INTEREST The Castle is more than 1,000 years old. It is open every day, and it is free.

The Ashridge Estate is a huge park with woods, views, and walks. There is a shop and a cafe.
