Berkhamsted OFFICIAL GUIDE

DESCRIPTION Berkhamsted is a historic market town 20 miles north of London. It has a population of 19,000, and is in the middle of beautiful English countryside.

PLACES OF INTEREST The Castle is more than 1,000 years old. It is open every day, and it is free.

The Ashridge Estate is a huge park with woods, views, and walks. There is a shop and a cafe.

TRAVEL There are four trains an hour into London. The journey takes 30-40 minutes.

HOTELS There are several hotels in the town. The biggest are the King's Arms Hotel and the Pennyfarthing Hotel, both in the High Street.

SHOPS There is everything you need in the High Street and Lower Kings Road. You will find chemists, bookshops, specialist food shops, clothes shops, bakers, dry cleaners - all the usual high street shops.

SUPERMARKETS The town has two big supermarkets, Waitrose and Tesco.

MARKET There is a street market every Saturday.

RESTAURANTS AND CAFES You will find French, Italian, Thai, and Indian restaurants.

There are also coffee bars and tea rooms on the High Street.

CINEMA The Rex Cinema is in a luxurious 1930s building.
