Modal Verbs

Modal Verbs: Modal verbs are auxiliary verbs that are used along with main verb to ability, permission, possibility, or necessity. Modal verbs include: (can, could, may, might, shall, should, will, and must). They precede the main verb in its base form and are not conjugated for number or person, so they do not change form.
