### **-Iraq inaugurates wastewater treatment plant in Babil**

Governor of Babil, Adnan al-Dulaimi, inaugurated on Monday a wastewater treatment plant with a capacity of 500 meters per hour. Al-Dulaimi said in a statement that the initiative marks an important turning point in tackling the water situation in northern Babil, particularly in villages and rural areas that have long been without stable water supplies.

### **-Iraq begins construction of Baghdad International Hospital**
