

Ask about time, occasion or moment.

For example,

When can i meet you?



Why

Asking For reason or explanation.

For example,

Why are you late?



Whose

Ask about ownership or possession.

For example,

Whose are these keys?



What

Asking For specific thing or object.

For example,

What is your name?



Whom

Asking about person (object of sentence).

You can replace it with "him" or "her".

For example,

Whom did you come with?



Who

Ask about person (subject of the sentence).

You can replace it with "he" or "she".

For example,

Who is that man?



Which

Asking about choice or preference.

For example,

Which is better, fruits or candy?
