What is the Future simple tense?



The future simple tense : - is used to express an action or events that will happen in the future.

For example :-

Don't worry about your exam , I'm sure you will pass.

Time Expressions



- Tomorrow , next week/month/year , in the future , soon , probably

EX:

He will be in Baghdad **tomorrow**.

They will buy a new car **next year**.

Form Affirmative



☞ **Subject + will\shall + basic verb + com.**

* Use (shall with I & We)

Ex:

1-We **Shall** travel to Baghdad **tomorrow**.

2- She **'ll** study for the exam **next week**.

Form Negative



☞ **Subject + will\shall + not + main verb+ com. ..**

Will+not = won't

Shall +not = shan't

Ex:

1- They **will not** go to the party **tomorrow**.

2- She **won't** study for the exam **next week**.
