What is the Future Simple Tense?



What is the Future simple tense?



The future simple tense : - is used to express an action or events that will happen in the future.

For example :-

Don't worry about your exam , I'm sure you will pass.

Time Expressions



- **Tomorrow , next week/month/year , in the future , soon , probably**

EX: He will be in Baghdad **tomorrow.**

EX : They will buy a new car **next year.**

Form Affirmative



❖ **Subject +will\shall + basic verb + com.**

* Use (will with he,she,it,you,they)

* Use (shall with I & We)

Ex:

1-We Shall travel to Baghdad tomorrow.

2- She 'll (will) study for the exam next week.

Form Negative



☞ **Subject + will\shall + not + basic verb+ com. ..**

Will+not = won't

Shall +not = shan't

Ex:

1- They **will not** go to the party **tomorrow**.

2- She **won't** study for the exam **next week**.

3- I **shan't** come **tomorrow**.
