- 5- Administer specific medication during labor and delivery.
- 6- carry out complete assessment and immediate care of the newborn.
- 7-Take decision in the use of episiotomy and perform it when necessary.
- 8-Assist with abnormal delivery, practice intervention according to the condition.
- 9-Perform postpartum examination and provide appropriate intervention.
